

#### Samuel Mulligan:

<sup>(1)</sup> ve been a student at GLBC For two years now, and both of my years have been a fantastic experience. I think one of the things that really sets a Bible college education apart is that it's not just about getting to know facts from a field of knowledge, it's about getting to know a person- and that person is Jesus Christ. So nothing is ever just theory. There's nothing that you learn for the test and then forget it. There is always more to learn about God, and each course brings a different aspect to that. Each course shed some light on who God is, or the relationship that we have with him, or how we should live our lives in this world. So we come away not just with more knowledge, but relationship to help me to grow in my spiritual gifts and my relationship with God and as a person.

For me the best experiences at Great Lakes have been hands-on partsthe assignments and ministry projects. There's a lot that you can learn from attending the lectures for any given course, but I found that it's in diving in for myself—to write a paper on that passage or make a presentation on that topic, there is a whole other level of depth that can be uncovered.

We have our ministry formation of courses each semester where we're encouraged to participate in a ministry initiative in our congregation and each time challenge it has challenged me, and pushed me it really benefited spiritually.

Paul Birston has said many times that all Christians are in ministry, and that really struck me. We're not all going to go into formal ministry, because we all have different spiritual gifts. God is calling each other to serve him in various ways and GLBC has very much helped to equip me to do just that."

## Roger Peterson Biblical Geography Scholarship

### Roger Peterson (1927–2008) was a gifted multi-talented

Christian gentleman, family man, preacher, teacher, missionary, principal, counsellor and builder who loved God and embodied the humility and joy of Jesus. Like his Saviour, Roger was born in a humble setting, a granary acting as a home 16 km south of Radville, Saskatchewan. His love of God and his sacrificial service blessed many people in his home, church, community, Western Christian College and Nigeria Christian College. One of Roger's favourite courses to teach was The Life of Christ. He included vivid descriptions and maps of the places Jesus' walked, preached, taught, healed and fed multitudes. Roger ignited appreciation for the beauty of Israel and the power of Biblical geography to magnify our understanding of God, His Word and the reality of His redeeming work in history.

In his honour, we are pleased to announce the Roger Peterson Biblical Geography Scholarship to enable credit students to study Biblical geography as early as possible in their program of studies to enhance all of their Bible text courses and life-long ministries. The scholarship includes tuition and a copy of an excellent atlas of Bible lands.
