Ambar's father abandoned the family. Her mother, Tania, makes and sells tortillas to bring in income. Ambar has one sister, Liliana (7). Their diet consists mainly of rice, beans, eggs, tortillas, vegetables and very little meat or dairy. They live in a small house made of wood with a concrete floor. They have electricity but no access to clean water. Ambar is a calm little girl. Her favorite animals are dogs and her favorite color is pink. She loves playing with dolls and helping her mother with chores. She dreams of becoming an engineer when she grows up. Tegucigalpa is the capital city of Honduras. Children in this program live in a slum neighborhood called Reynel Funez. Most houses in this area are poorly constructed and don't have indoor plumbing. CRF runs an after-school program and a computer lab where children can come and receive help with their homework and spiritual training.
