Understanding the Lord's Supper

For Churches of Christ, the sharing of the Lord's Supper is central to our identity; it's central to our communal worship. To be in communal worship and to not commune around the Table of the Lord, we are left with a sense of emptiness; that something has been missing and lacking in our worship. To aid us in developing a rich and deep theological understanding of the Lord's

Supper, a series of videos by Dr. John Mark Hicks will lead us deeper into the Scriptures and into the practice of sharing the Table. Participants will be engaged in an in-depth study of the Lord's Supper with the intention of helping participants take what we are learning back to the local congregational settings. In this way, theology will inform our practice.
