But, this email is different.

I am asking you for an end-of-year donation to help us close-out 2022. We have a few days left in this year and we need your support. Each dollar goes directly into the work we do. Here is a snapshot of things happening at Micah 6 Community this week:

- We are helping a neighbor get the lumber needed to replace old floor joists in her sagging home.
- We took a family of children to see the new Avatar movie this week.
- We are assisting other organizations by getting hats and gloves for their young clients.
- We took over 400 hand warmers to our local homeless shelter.
- We are checking in on elderly neighbors who live alone during this cold snap and handing out more than 25 space heaters.

- We are reaching out to locally owned and minority owned contractors to make sure they are included in the bid process at Webster Community Center.
- We are delivering produce bags to 60 households around the city in a partnership with Community Housing Network, funded by Pontiac Community Foundation.

All of this during the "week off" between Christmas and New Years. The work here doesn't stop, especially if we have neighbors who are cold, kids who are out of school, and opportunities to serve.

Maybe you've been meaning to donate, but you just needed a reminder.

Maybe you've already donated this year, but have some funds left over in your budget.

Maybe you've always thought donating was for others.

Maybe you think that your \$10, \$15, or \$25 doesn't really matter.
