1) GOSPEL SHARE AT A GYM

"I have found that Christianity and the logics of the Bible have REALLY saved me from becoming lost elsewhere."

Three months ago, a young Cambridge man heard the gospel for the first time at the gym from a disciple in our network. I was asked to meet with him because he's very philosophical and I'm known as a real thinker (Overthinker? I'm not so sure, haha).

He had never read a word of the Bible in his life. "Where WAS this for the last 8 years!?" he asked me, as he held up his little already-worn New Testament.



2) SERVING THE HOMELESS

It's that time of year again! We switch from doing outreach at parks to doing outreach on the streets and sometimes at malls.

Many homeless are in need of gloves, warm socks, blankets and food.

Ministry on the streets is always unpredictable. One night, we split up. I ended up calling 9-1-1 because of a homeless man stumbling around, then sitting, then pretty much totally incoherent.

Compare my experience with the experience of the rest of the group...Here's what happened with them:

"Amazing night! We got to pray for lots of people, gave away tons of food, coats, gloves, etc. Two of us prayed for a man who received the message of the gospel and one of us reconnected with a woman who has been going through scripture and wants to get baptized. It was awesome to see the young people pass things out and get involved. Praise God!"

Please pray that we get more winter supplies for our outreaches.



3) PRAYER

I've been called to more prayer lately. The dual facets of prayer, encompassing both the intimate communion where God ministers to me and the intercession on behalf of others.

I'm learning that we can know that He is ministering to us in prayer if we are naturally led to pray for others.
