Gardens are going!

Gardening season here really starts in mid-March thanks to our amazing four-season greenhouse. For a second year, we were able to open the door to our growing friends at Growing Pontiac and The Farm at Trinity Oakland to help start their growing season early as well. Together, we stared close to 10,000 seedings together. This head start is already paying off for all of our organizations since we are harvesting our first crops now.

Summer Youth Employment!

One of the things that we started last year and have been thrilled to get back to in 2024 is our Summer Youth Employment Program. This program is a partnership with the Michigan Department of Natural Resources that hires students to engage in careers in the outdoors. Last year we hired six students as our trial-run of the program and spent the year taking the lessons learned to create an event better program this year.

This year, our program was able to expand and we hired nine teens, two of them returning from last year. One of the best parts about our work is that we have known most of these students since they were in grade school and it is a real honor to continue getting to know then as we provide some of their first jobs.

This summer our teens will learn how to canoe and kayak, assisting in clean ups in hard-to-reach places on the Clinton River. They'll assist with invasive species remediation. They'll help to balance pond biomes and learn about sampling and testing water. They'll contribute to projects to improve area State Parks and visit a dark sky park. They have a full summer ahead of them!





Summer Kids Programs Have Stared!

Now that school is out, we are in full-on summer kids programs mode. Swim lessons, field trips, baseball games, water wars, Meet Up and Eat Up, bike fix-its, and more are all up and going.

Progress at Webster
