If you are interested in knowing how the holiday season was in my home, my answer is: Busy and wonderful. From December 4th to January 5th I was in a non-stop study via the internet with a person in India who was a member of the "Laymen's Evangelical Fellowship". He had been out of that movement for 4 years and was correctly teaching salvation according to his own research in the Scriptures and by baptizing but without questioning his own previous conversion. After a month of study with him, he called upon a preacher from the Church of Christ in India to be immersed according to the holy doctrine.

I was not there to witness his joy but I must tell you that this is for me the greatest gift of my 75 years and my 50 years of Christian life. Our assembly in Plessisville now has the joy of being involved in the work of the Lord in a country that represents almost 20% of the world's population. I communicate with him in English because I don't speak Telugu, which is the language of the Andhra Pradesh region in south-east India.

The bike path is in the forest. I leave at 5:30 am after walking our dog. I am alone on the path at this time of day so a perfect opportunity to pray, meditate and especially sing without disturbing the ears of the brothers and sisters. I lost 7 kilos (15 lbs). But my survival so far relies more on the encouragement, the faith, work and balance of my wife who acts in the shadows although she is guided internally by the light of the Word. Next June 26 will be our 50th wedding anniversary. God has graced me by giving me the support I needed so much.

Together we want to thank you for all the spiritual and material assistance you have provided which has given an inestimable meaning to our life and which we hope to have shared with our neighbor.
