Last summer, a family who had recently arrived from Vietnam happened upon one of our Lemonade Parties at a local park. This moment marked the beginning of a transformative journey for their daughters, Han and Nghi.

"We arrived in Canada on August 2nd, 2024, and my children were thrilled to join CityKidz in September," their mother shares. "The games [at the Lemonade Party] were so exciting they immediately asked me to register them [for the CityKidz program] when we got home." She hoped these opportunities would help them build friendships, embrace their new community, and feel a sense of belonging.

Just a week after arriving in Canada, Han and Nghi were officially signed up for CityKidz. Their mother recalls their joy as they anticipated their first Saturday bus ride. From that moment, the CityKidz red bus became a weekend highlight, taking them to a theatre filled with fun and laughter. Outgoing Han embraced activities energetically, while shy Nghi found comfort in the volunteers' kindness.

At CityKidz, they found more than fun and games; they found a sense of belonging.

The CityKidz Christmas Party brought magic to their holiday season. They were excited to get to wear their pyjamas, engage in a lively game of 'pass the present', experience a visit from Santa and share in the festive meal, songs and stories that make the annual Christmas party such an anticipated event!

And of course, Han & Nghi were so thrilled to receive gifts like craft kits and other items they had on their wish lists. They had never received such generous gifts before.

Han and Nghi's excitement was contagious as they shared stories about their adventures. In December, their mother posted on Facebook, sharing heartfelt gratitude. "In the blink of an eye, three months have passed. My kids were nervously joining CityKidz, and now they're saying goodbye to the last bus ride of 2024. They love the red bus rides, fun games, and especially the snacks. Love U CityKidz."

In their "before" photo, Han and Nghi stood shyly in front of the red bus, their expressions a mix of curiosity and nervousness. In the "after" shot, their smiles radiated confidence and joy. Missy, their route captain, stood with them in both pictures, a constant source of encouragement. "Missy is so kind and patient," their mother shares. "My children always felt loved and cared for by the CityKidz team."
