# COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

NATHAN BROWN

## SAMUEL & KINGS (15 WEEKS)

These books describe the 'Monarchy Period' of Israel's history. Beginning with the last of the judges, this study covers the United and Divided Kingdoms of Israel, including their exploits in international politics and religious apostasy leading to exile.

## CHURCH HISTORY I (15 WEEKS)

A survey of the history of the church from the first century until the end of the thirteenth century. The course will introduce the influential figures of this period and the contextual pressures that influenced them. Unfortunately, departures from the New Testament pattern dominate the story of this period. Nevertheless, there remain lessons, both positive and negative, that we can learn from how professing Christians interpreted Scripture, served others, and interacted with the world around them.

## OLD TESTAMENT WORLD (8 WEEKS: MAR-APR)

An introduction to the historical contexts in which the stories of Old Testament events are to be understood. A study of the social, religious, economic, and political settings of the ancient Near East.

## EPHESIANS, PHILIPPIANS, COLOSSIANS & PHILEMON (15 WEEKS)

An in-depth, verse-by-verse textual study of Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, and Philemon in their historical, religious, social and geographical contexts. Special attention is given to Paul's high view of Jesus, His death and resurrection for our redemption and His eternal work of Creation. Insights gained will be helpful in preaching, teaching, missions, evangelism, disciple-making, counselling, and personal spiritual growth.

## BIBLICAL PREACHING (12 WEEKS: LAST WEEK OF JAN-APR)

A practical introduction to Biblical preaching for men interested in preaching occasionally, more often or eventually full-time. A great refresher for men with preaching experience. The course reviews God's priority of preaching in proclaiming the gospel and equipping His people. We develop skills in: selecting passages, identifying their key eternal messages, historical backgrounds, sermon forms, outlines, manuscripts and sermon delivery to help listeners experience the transforming power of God's Word and their application in living today.

## UNDERSTANDING CULTURE - ENGAGING PEOPLE (8 WEEKS: MAR-APR)

Understanding the cultures of our neighbours locally and globally enhances our ability to build relationships, engage them with God and His Word, and communicate the gospel. This course will explore the cultures of the world and Canada historically and in the 21st century in light of 12 dimensions of their formation, the cultures of people in Scripture, and ultimately the culture of heaven.
